MINUTES

Meeting of 30 January 2007, from 09h00 to 12h30 and from 15h00 to 18h30
BRUSSELS

(The constituent meeting at the mid-point in the parliamentary term-2007, scheduled for 9.00 was postponed to 1 February 2007. As a result, the meeting took place under the former conditions which prevailed in the first half of the legislature.)

The meeting opened at 9h34 on Tuesday 30 January 2007, with Marcin Libicki (Chairman) in the chair.

1. Adoption of draft agenda (PE 384.273)

The chairman transmitted the apologies presented by *Michael Cashman*, first Vice chairman, who was not able to participate in this meeting due to important business in London.

The chairman furthermore announced the following:

- The **constituent meeting** of the committee, which would signal an increase in the size of the Petitions Committee to 40 members, would be at 9.30 on Thursday February 1st.
- Items 1, 2, 3, and 32 were **postponed**; Indents 'Rules of Procedure of the Committee on Petitions' and 'Guidelines' under item 7 (Any other business) would be placed on the agenda of the February 26-27 meeting when the new members of the Committee would be present.
- Item 18 was postponed until February at the request of the petitioner and the Commission;
- Item 25 was also postponed at the request of Ms Wallis, rapporteur.

- A large number of **petitioners** would be **attending** the meeting on the following points:
 - Items 8 - 13, concerning Property restitution,

- Item 14, concerning discrimination on the grounds of language,
- Items 19-22, concerning citizens rights in Latvia where the Latvian Permanent Representative would also speak on behalf of the Latvian Government and Adrian Severin, MEP and Rapporteur for the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe on Latvia would also speak;
- Item 33 concerning a Waste Incinerator in Dublin Bay;
- Item 34 concerning pollution in Kilkenny and its impact on cattle;
- Item 35, for which presentations would be heard from 6 petitioners as well as from the President du Conseil Général du Loiret, concerning the proposals to build a by-pass around Orléans.

Carlos José Iturgaiz Angulo requested petition nr. 1001/2005 under item 41, to be dealt with under a separate item since the subject was a different one. It was agreed to treat it as item 41a).

Proinsias De Rossa requested that items 16 and 17, concerning Estonia, would be taken after item 22.

The agenda was approved.

2. Approval of minutes of 20-21 November 2006 (PE 382.482)

The minutes were approved.

3. Chairman's announcements

It was proposed to **re-open** the following petition on the basis of new information provided by the petitioner:

- Petition **658/2005** concerning a dispute regarding the installation of a satellite;
- Petition **230/2005** concerning pension entitlements by the Spanish social security authority INNS and unfair treatment as a migrant worker.

The following petitions should be **closed**:

- Petition **955/2005** on the basis of a response from the Human Right's Sub-Committee which was informed of the petition and asked to comment. A special letter would be sent to the petitioners on the basis of this response and a copy of the Parliament resolution on Turkey's progress towards accession which also contains a reference to the Greek genocide in Pontus;
- Petition **469/2005** on the damage to the environment, landscape and cultural heritage as a result of a town-planning project in San Lorenzo de el Escorial region. The petitioner was asked for more detailed information but never replied.

In the B section, **item 44** would be placed on the **A section** at the next meeting at the request of *David Hammerstein Mintz*.

4. Any other business

The chairman informed members that the committee had received a report from the Greek authorities concerning the case of Claire Baker, a UK resident who petitioned the committee and who had been supported in particular by Sir Robert Atkins.

The chairman underlined that the document, which was the result of a special investigation by the Greek Interior Ministry on the activities of the customs authorities was **confidential** and contained information concerning individual privacy covered under the terms of the Convention on Personal Data Protection. Therefore it was being made available for the information of the Chairman and Sir Robert Atkins only. The secretariat would keep a copy for the Committee archives. The names contained in the document were not to be disclosed in the event that a discussion should later take place on this subject.

Carlos José Iturgaiz Angulo, Sir Robert Atkins and Proinsias de Rossa spoke on the planned fact-finding mission to Spain. It was agreed to continue the discussion during the coordinators meeting.
