"Defending tenants rights" is the first publication in Russia, and in Russian language. It is a review of different Tenant issues. Tenants are a housing "minority" in Russia, but still there are about 20 millions of tenants - both letting flats from municipalities and private persons. It is wide international review - about different landlords and different tenants, about tenancy agreements, tenants problems and victories as well as about social housing.

Some parts are about activities of the International Union of Tenants (IUT), and tenant unions in different countries - especially Sweden and Czech Republic.

I have also included a lot of information about tenant representatives' in the U.K. - especially TAROE and KFTRA and TPAS.

There also information about Russian Union of Tenants - very new NGO.

I hope that Russian speaking people from all of the former Soviet Union will find this booklet useful.
