



A tenure neutral policy is necessary

- Tenure neutrality means that ways of finance and the tax system do not favour any tenure form
- Big subsidies to home-owners bigger profits to build for homeownership than rental housing

We need subsidies that lower prices

- Subsidies and/or subsidized housing are necessary.
- Any subsidy must be tied to conditions, so that it results in lower prices or lower rents.
- Subsidies without any conditions "dope" prices, hurt the economy and make it more difficult for new households to enter the housing market





Mixed tenure forms and affordable rental housing

- Political decisions:
 - subsidies,
 - fair rental laws,
 - regulated rents,
 - counteract land speculation
- Lower construction and land prices
- Different forms of non-profit or low profit rental housing
- Create cities open for all!

Rent regulation


- Necessary for a sound and fair rental market
- Security of tenure Control of rent increase for sitting tenants
- Free rent setting for new tenancies hamper mobility
- Deregulation has never resulted in increased construction of rental housing according to several research reports
